Everking Mission & Vision

STAFF JOB DESCRIPTION

WORKSHOP LEADER

PURPOSE: The Everking Workshop Leader will serve lead a topical workshop to 1) reveal who God is through Bible teaching and prayer; 2) encourage the students to advance the Kingdom of God in their daily live by giving appropriate challenges; 3) will encourage students to connect with each other through ice-breaker activities.

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. At least 21 years of age, willing to agree to Standards of Conduct and Ministry Covenant.
2. A committed Christian with a definite sense of God's calling to ministry with students.
3. A person with a servant's spirit and gifting, who can organize, lead and teach students. Must be able to properly exegete and apply God's Word in a way that is engaging to students. Must have the spiritual gift of teaching.
4. A person who has a desire to see youth won to faith in Christ and disciplined as believers of Christ.
5. A person who is a self-starter and team player and is motivated to work hard in the ministry to the Lord.

DURATION: Length of workshops vary by volume of topic material, but should not exceed 7 weeks. Duration will be set by Youth Pastor, specified in Ministry Covenant, and agreed to by Workshop Leader.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Work under the supervision of the Youth Pastor to teach a topical workshop, as selected and provided by the Youth Pastor. Youth will be taught with provided curriculum and/or literature and properly interpreted/applied scripture in a creative and challenging style.
2. Will strive to create a workshop environment that is creative, friendly and challenging.
3. Read (or watch/listen to) assigned workshop teaching materials; be fully prepared for each workshop lesson in advance, including provision of handouts and use of visual aids.
4. Make efforts to maintain personal interest in students' lives. Will ensure that workshop attendance sheet is completed and submitted to Youth Pastor.
5. Will provide leadership to Youth Apprentice Team member(s) who assist with workshop responsibilities, when applicable.
6. Enforce Everking rules and expectations during workshop; stress safety.
7. Youth Pastor will ensure workshop logistics (e.g., location, food, curriculum, materials) are provided for workshop. No expenses are to come from Workshop Leader.
